- 2** Tailor interventions that mitigate inhaled threats

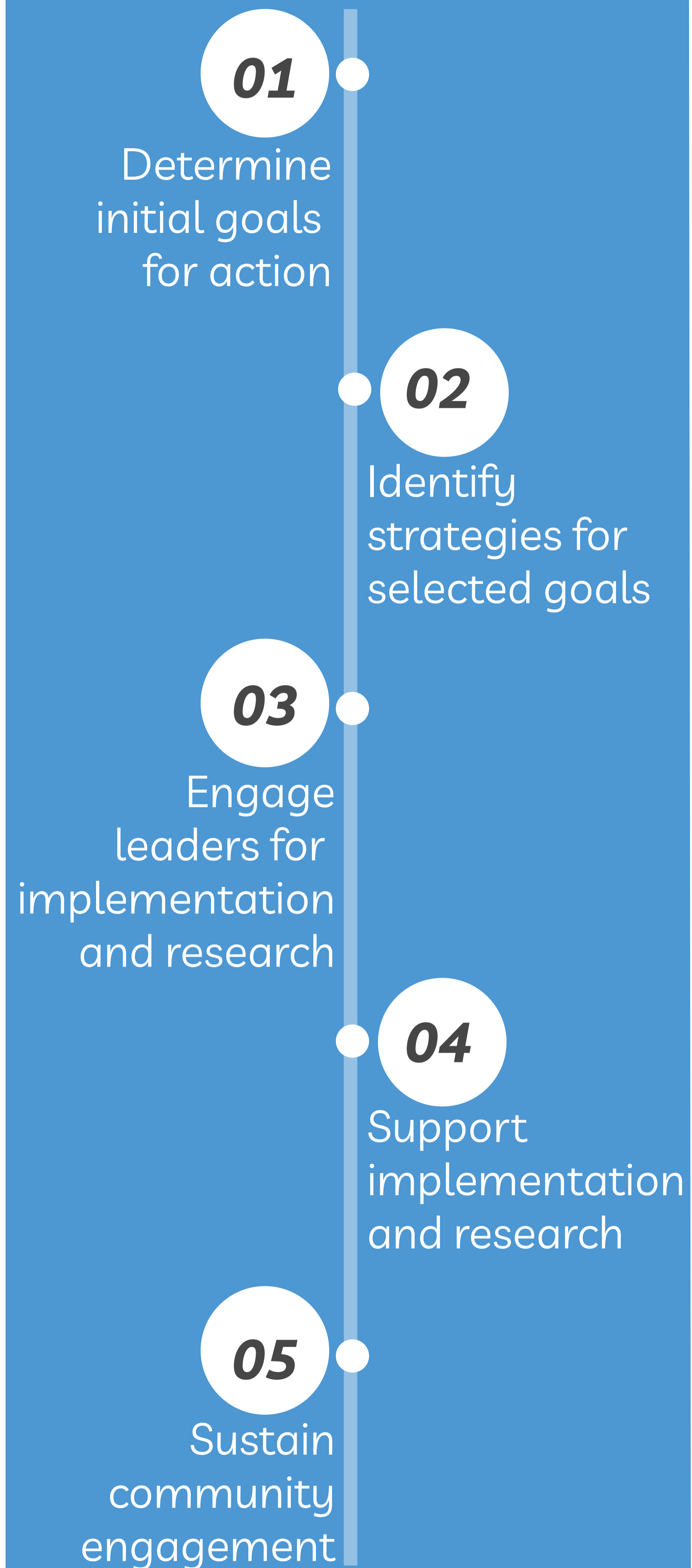
Care
